

This European collaboration has reinforced our belief that when we join forces, we can achieve great things, and has proved to be a powerful asset in delivering great gaming experiences for our players.



### GAME MECHANICS

EuroDreams is the **first game featuring monthly payout prizes spanning multiple European countries.** 

For €2.50, this new draw game gives players the chance to win up to €20,000 a month for 30 years, or €7.2 million.

To play, simply fill in **six numbers** (out of 40) **plus one bonus "Dream" number** (out of 5) to make up a full set.

EuroDreams tickets go on sale on **Monday, 30 October 2023**. Players in France can validate their lottery tickets **in person at a point of sale, online at www.fdj.fr or on FDJ's mobile app.** 

EuroDreams gives players the chance to win the jackpot in the form of a monthly payout prize. The second-tier prize is also a monthly payout, this time of  $\leq$ 2,000 a month for five years, or  $\leq$ 120,000.

The first draw will take place on **Monday, 6 November**. Thereafter, there will be two draws a week, **on Mondays and Thursdays.**

#### ELECTRONIC DRAWS







EuroDreams draws will be conducted electronically and will only be available online, in the "Results" tab of FDJ's website (www.fdj.fr) and mobile app.



Thanks to its expertise, La Française des Jeux will be responsible for draws for the entire EuroDreams community. These draws will therefore be carried out in France.



On draw nights, players will have until 8:15 p.m. to validate their tickets. The draw will take place at around 9 p.m., with the results posted online at around 10 p.m. Betting will reopen at 8:30 p.m. for the following draws.



The winning numbers will be revealed through a brand-new video animation.

#### ABOUT FRENCH WINNERS

All EuroDreams players who win the maximum prize will have access to guidance and support offered by FDJ, should they wish.

All winners of €1 million and up are invited to the La Française des Jeux head office in Boulogne-Billancourt to collect their winnings. Players who win the EuroDreams jackpot will also be invited to the Paris region.

Each big winner has access to FDJ's Winners' Experience and Support team, which offers personalised individual support upon payment, followed by optional, free group support for at least five years. Winners can take part in around 15 workshops a year on a range of topics, including wealth management, notary management and change management.

FDJ has been a pioneer in offering personalised follow-up to its winners for over 25 years, and has inspired many foreign lotteries to do so as well.




#### ADVERTISING CAMPAIGN
